

Athletic Activities

Purpose:

To bring home schooling families together for athletic activities, in an environment that promotes Christian values and sportsmanship, and to provide access to activities in which the students might not otherwise have an opportunity to participate.

Guidelines

1. Athletes participating should be members of CHES.
2. Athletes must meet the age requirements for the activity.
3. Athletes must maintain a behavior of respectable Christian ladies or gentlemen at all times, on and off the court or playing field.

*Not all activities are available every year. As always, if minimum participation requirements are not met, or there is no leadership, the activity will be deleted from the calendar.

Cost

In some cases, participation will require a fee. The fee will be determined by the board. Some expenses may be covered by participation fees, proceeds from game admission and concessions, and the CHES group. Parents may be responsible for the cost of any food, lodging, and other travel expenses; and may be required to purchase uniforms.

Responsibilities

Parents - provide transportation to and from all activities, or make alternate arrangements ahead of time. When necessary, parents will provide lodging, food, or other travel expenses for their child, and will purchase the uniform.

Athletes - will be willing to work with others, will attend scheduled practices and games when required, and are responsible for the care of their uniform.

Coach - provides learning atmosphere and maintains Christian values. The coach will be an example. The coach will work with the Athletics Coordinator, parents, and board as necessary, to schedule games, practices, and other team activities.
